Bushidō represented regulations for samurai attitudes and behavior which evolved significantly through history. It is loosely analogous to the European concept of chivalry. Bushido refers not only to martial rectitude, but to personal rectitude: Rectitude or justice, is the strongest virtue of Bushido. A well-known samurai defines it this way: 'Rectitude is one's power to decide upon a course of conduct in accordance with reason, without wavering; to die when to die is right, to strike when to strike is right.'
